What to Bring When You Register Your Vehicle:

1. Car Registration
2. Valid Driver's License (not a Learner's Permit)
3. Payment of \$35.00 (No refunds will be given)
4. Vehicle (the permit must be placed in the window by school personnel)

Millard Public School officials feel that it is imperative for each student who drives a motor vehicle to school and his/her parents/guardians to read sign and subscribe to the following conditions.

1. Operate my motor vehicle in a safe and courteous manner on and around the Millard high school campus and other Millard school district properties.
2. Park my vehicle properly and promptly upon arrival at school and that I will not loiter in or around any parked car on school property.
3. To park my car in areas designated by the Student Handbook.
4. Abide by the 10 mph speed limit at all times on campus.
5. To display a parking permit when parking a vehicle on campus.
6. Not loan, transfer or sell my parking permit to any other student for any reason.
7. In the event that I lose my permit, if it is stolen, or if my permit is not displayed while I am parked on campus, I understand that it is my responsibility to sign-in my car or a car that my family is legally in possession of in the office and to notify office personnel. In addition, if I should receive a ticket after I have accepted this responsibility, I understand that I must take the ticket to the office in order to have it canceled and update records.
8. Additional parking permits can be purchased for an additional fee.
9. **Students who purchase a new vehicle or change license plates must report the new information to the office.**
10. **Students who purchase a permit after January 1 of the current school year, will be charged \$17.50.**

I understand that this permit **DOES NOT GUARANTEE** me a parking space on campus. Rather, this permit merely allows me the privilege of parking on campus on a first come first serve basis if legal student parking is available. Students who come to school after 1st period or who leave during the day may not find parking available. I fully understand that if legal student parking is not available on campus, I will not park in any illegal areas (handicapped, islands, staff, grassy areas, or fire lanes), but will park off campus. I will comply with all driving and parking regulations as prescribed by the State of Nebraska and Millard high school campus. In the event that I do not comply with these regulations, I understand consequences may occur, including discipline, parking fines, revocation of parking privileges, immobilization of my vehicle with a tire lock or boot, and towing of my vehicle at my expense.

I further understand that the school is not responsible for any damage, theft, or loss to or from my vehicle. In addition, if school officials have reasonable suspicion or law enforcement officers have probable cause, to believe that there are illegal items or substances in my vehicle I give my consent to such people to search my vehicle. I also understand that dogs may be used to determine whether my vehicle contains illegal items or substances, and illegal items or substances may be seized.
